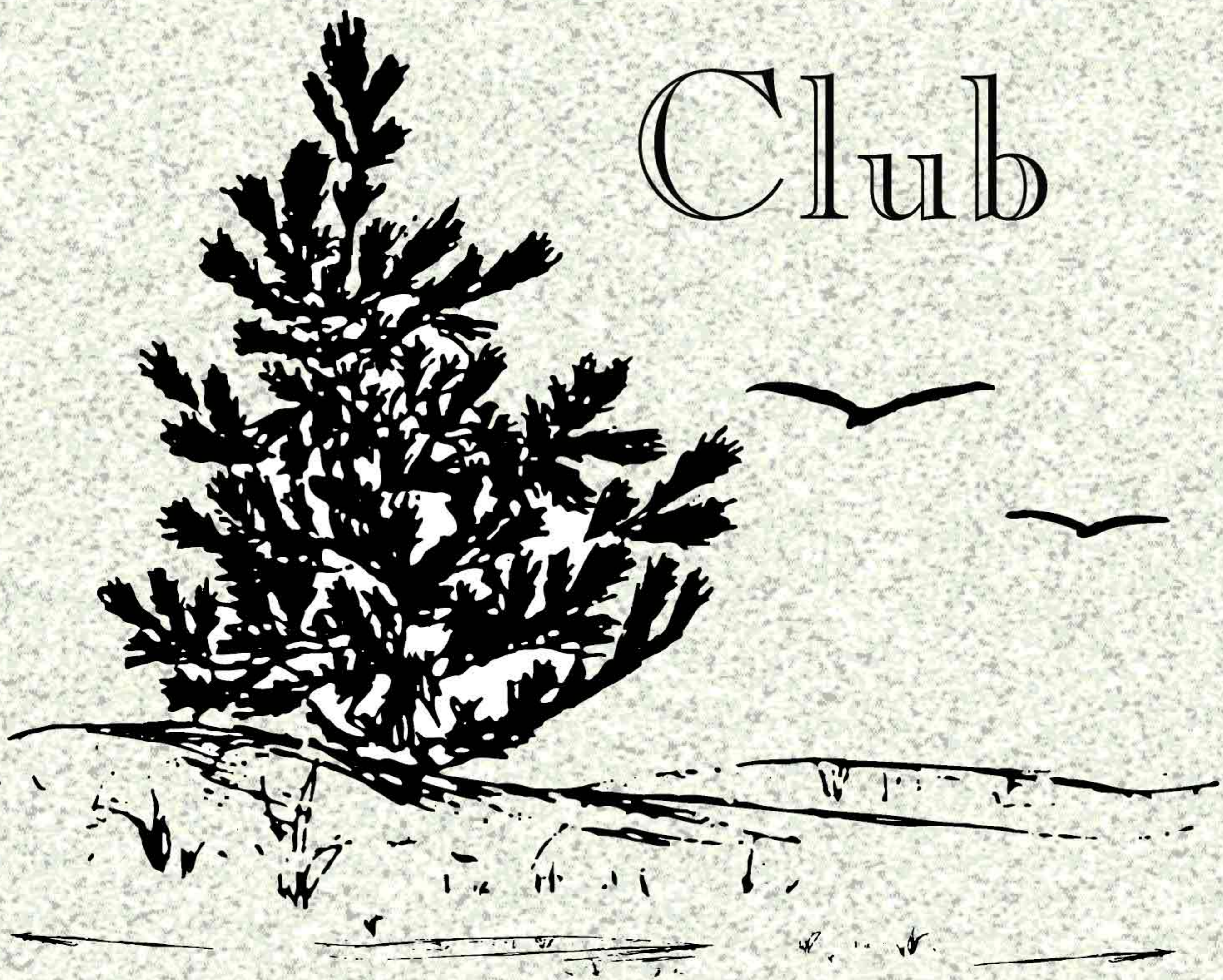

In 1988 we were proud recipients of the National Take Pride In America Award presented by President Reagan. and we were recognized in July, 2001, by our State Legislature for our efforts in helping to “make Brigantine one of the most beautiful communities in New Jersey.”
